## History and Objectives

2. To create and maintain information resources which can expedite and enhance a member's search for information regarding the science and technology of energetic materials as well as information on devices and applications which utilize energetic materials.
3. To sponsor or sanction symposia on topics in the field of energetic materials research, development, technology, and applications at such intervals as may be appropriate to further its first purpose as stated above.
4. To encourage research and education in the science and technology of energetic materials.

Even though the Society was officially formed in 1980, its history began in a substantive way when the First International Pyrotechnics Seminar was held in Estes Park, Colorado, USA in August 1968. The seminars, held in even-numbered years in the United States, have grown from approximately 50 attendees representing three countries in 1968, to 239 attendees from 18 countries at the 44th Seminar in 2019. Society-Sponsored Seminars also have been held in Germany, France, Spain, United Kingdom, Sweden, China, New Zealand, Russia, Japan, and Australia.

## Membership

Membership is open to all persons of good character who can demonstrate a bonafide interest in pyrotechnics, defined in the broad sense to include all exothermic energetic materials, whether for commercial or military applications.
